



For the last 40 years Pekingese have been **JANET ALLEN'S** passion – as an owner, breeder, exhibitor, judge and foremost lover of the breed. As a partner in Sing Lee Pekingese for many years, she made up over 50 champions with numerous BIS and BISS winners (including 2 national specialty winners). She continues to own (and occasionally show) Pekingese and remains active in club activities.

Janet is honored to have judged specialties throughout the US and award CCs in England, Australia and New Zealand- and judge Pekingese in China, Korea and Taiwan. An AKC judge- Toy and Non-Sporting Groups, Janet is active in judge's education, with the objective of sharing an understanding and appreciation of our special breed. She takes very seriously her role as a mentor for newcomers, as well as her continuing dialogue with established breeders and exhibitors. It is with appreciation and with a commitment to Pekingese that she is considered to judge the 2020 PCA National Specialty.



In the late 1960's, **DANA CLINE'S** parents gave him his first Great Dane and from that moment he knew that he would have a lifetime of involvement with this breed and with dogs.

As a young child he exhibited in 4H, training in both obedience and conformation. He found the dog show world in his teenage years, spending nearly every weekend traveling to shows, helping professional handlers and handling dogs for friends with other breeds as well. While his main interest was always in Great Danes, he worked hard to learn about other breeds and to become more active in all breeds. All his weekends spent at dogs shows eventually led him to a career as a professional handler, where he specialized in Danes and sight hounds, but also handling various other breeds along the way.

Breeding has always been a favorite aspect of this sport for Mr. Cline and currently breeds and exhibits Tibetan Mastiffs and Italian Greyhounds. He has bred nearly 100 champions in several breeds, primarily Great Danes, but also Borzoi, German Wirehaired Pointers, Miniature Bull Terriers, Beagles, Italian Greyhounds, and Tibetan Mastiffs and is also a Breeder of Merit. He was a long-time member of the Great Dane Club of America. He is a member of The American Tibetan Mastiff Association. Mr. Cline is an All-Breed Judge. He has judged in several foreign countries, multiple National Specialties, as well as many of the country's top shows. He was also the Recipient of the 2017 AKC Judge of the Year.



DAVID FITZPATRICK has been involved in the dog fancy since 1970. This year marks his 48th consecutive year of dedication to purebred dogs and Pekingese. Until 2014 David was occupationally ineligible to judge Pekingese in America, but he has enjoyed judging at Championship shows overseas for many years.

David was awarded the Dogs In Review magazine Winkie for Annual Achievement for Best Professional Handler in 2006. In 2009, he was recognized by the American Kennel Club as the Toy Group Breeder of the Year, as well as Mentor of the Year by The Pekingese Association.

As a breeder he has bred 80 champion Pekingese of whom 12 are Best in Show winners. Many have also had notable wins at The Pekingese Club of America shows and The Westminster Kennel Club. David has shown many of the top winning Pekingese of the last 4 decades, including Ch Yakee If Only the top winning Pekingese of all time in the USA and Top Dog All Breeds for 2005, as well as his Ch Palacegarden Malachy the Best in Show winner at the 2012 Westminster Kennel Club.
